



# TIMELY WARNING

In compliance with the “Timely Warning” provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act) the Grand Canyon University Public Safety Department is giving notice of an offense reported to have occurred in the Rivers Garage located at 5313 N 29<sup>th</sup> Ave and the Missouri Garage located at 5346 N 29<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Reported Offense: Motor Vehicle Thefts

Suspect/s: Unknown

Incident Information: On 11/7/2022 a Chevrolet Silverado truck was reported stolen from the Missouri garage. The incident occurred sometime between 10/31/2022 and 11/7/2022. On 11/6/2022 an attempted theft of a Kia Sportage was reported in the Rivers Garage. This incident occurred sometime between 11/5/2022 and 11/6/2022. Also, on 10/31/2022 another Chevrolet Silverado truck was reported stolen from the Missouri Garage and has since been recovered. This incident occurred sometime between 10/29/2022 and 10/31/2022.

Prevention Information:

GCU Public Safety has increased police and security patrols in our garages. GCU Police are also working with outside police agencies to investigate and deter these crimes.

GCU Public Safety also offers the following vehicle theft prevention tips:

- Always close your windows and lock your vehicle when parked. Do not keep a spare key in or around your vehicle.
- Consider using a steering wheel lock, alarm system, ignition kill switch or tracking system as a theft deterrent.
